## Exploring the Now

The experience of time is subjective. A short moment can be perceived as long and rich in content, or days can go by without trace. Through a systematical combination of concepts from arts and cognitive science we investigate possibilities to change the perceived quality and duration of the present moment. In three interactive installations the visitors get the opportunity to play with time and space to modify the subjectively perceived „Now“.

At each installation several visitors can make a new mapping between physical actions and sensual experiences. In this manner it becomes possible to intuitively experiment with the personal perception of presence.

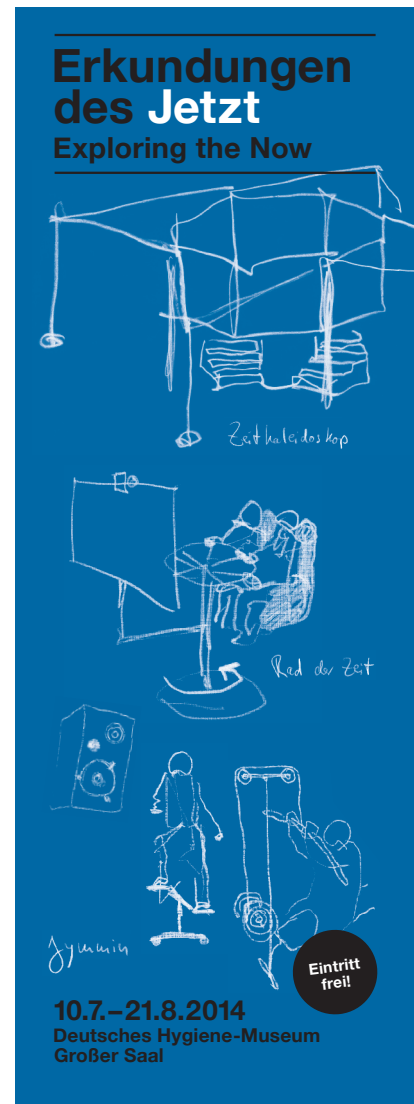
