“EXCELLENT DISSERTATION WITHIN THE LAST 6 YEARS“

The relevant date is the official conferral date of the doctoral degree (generally, the date on the doctoral certificate) in relation to the nomination deadline. Nominations of scientists with a “Dr. med.” will be accepted as well.

The time frame can be extended for the following periods:

- Parental leave for children born before or after the completion of the doctorate (women: standard extension of 18 months per child or actual parental leave period, if it exceeds 18 months / men: actual parental leave period)
- Clinical qualification (e.g. specialist medical training) after completion of the dissertation
- Long-term illness (more than 90 days) after completion of the dissertation
- Long-term illness of family member or close relative (child, spouse, parents, siblings) after completion of the dissertation
- Military service / voluntary service (e.g. voluntary social year) after completion of the dissertation

All exceptional cases must be evidenced by official documents.

If you have an additional PhD/doctoral degree in another field, the relevant date is the conferral date of the first doctoral degree.
